Minutes of the 26<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Mission Operation Greens held over Webex  
(online meeting portal) on 22.02.2021 at 03.00 pm

The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary, FPI to consider 13 claim applications received for transportation/ storage subsidy under extended Operation Greens (TOP to TOTAL) scheme and to scrutinize 4 proposal received for setting up of the integrated value chain project under the scheme.

Members of the Mission Operation Greens (MOG) and PMAs (GT & NABCONS) attended the meeting. The list of participants of the meeting is at Annexure-I.

2. At the outset, Chairman welcomed the participants and intimated the purpose of the meeting.
3. Detailed presentations were made by the PMAs on the transport/storage subsidy claims and subsequent clarifications submitted by the applicants. Mission examined whether the applicants have complied with the eligibility criterion, documentation requirements for online claim for transport/storage subsidy in case of short term proposals. PMA have shown the relevant supporting documents from the online portal to the members in support of their recommendation.

Mission further noted that the trigger price for Onion crop in the Nasik is ₹ 40.55, which seems to be quite high.

Mission found crop buyer name on the transport invoice instead of applicant in one of the transport invoice. Therefore, Mission advised the PMA to verify all the challans for all the transport entries to check if the invoices have been raised in the name of N N Traders. Mission also advised the PMA to ask the applicant to submit the declaration certificate from buyer side where their name was mentioned in the invoices. PMA cross checked the all entries and found 11 entries where the name of the buyer has been indicated as the consignee in the invoice of the transporter instead of the applicant. PMA asked the applicant to submit the declaration from buyer side as advised by Mission.

The applicant submitted and uploaded the buyer declaration certificate on the portal and the same was checked by the PMA. The declaration certificate from buyer side where their name was mentioned in the invoices found in the order.

PMA informed that it has examined the claim and received all the clarifications and supporting documents for transportation subsidy claims from the applicant and found the same in order. The payment for transportation cost was done by the applicant as checked from the bank account statement and the crop was also sold by the applicant to the buyer.

Representative of the applicant attended the WebEx Meeting held on 22.02.2021.

PMA informed that it has examined the claim and received all the clarifications and supporting documents for transportation subsidy claims from the applicant and found the same in order.

PMA informed that toll plaza receipts for 14 trucks (Transport-3, 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 14, 15, 17, 18, 24, 28, 29, and 30) out of total 30 have not been submitted by the applicant. However, all the transport activities have been done before 27.08.2020 (relaxation date for FASTag Statement) except Transport-30. Therefore, Transport-30 has been considered as an ineligible transport and excluded from eligible subsidy calculation. PMA informed that the applicant has not uploaded RC and Permit for Transport-20. Therefore, the PMA considered this transport as an ineligible transportation and not considered for eligible subsidy calculation.
