The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary, FPI to discuss the proposals under extended Operation Greens (TOP to TOTAL) scheme to consider 6 claim applications received under short term price stabilization scheme and to scrutinize one proposal received for setting up of the integrated value chain project and request of one existing PIA under the scheme.

Members of the Mission Operation Greens (MOG), PMAs (GT & NABCONS) attended the meeting. The list of participants of the meeting is at Annexure-I.

2. At the outset, Chairman welcomed the participants and intimated the purpose of the meeting.
3. Detailed presentations were made by the PMA on the proposals and subsequent clarifications submitted by the applicant. Mission examined whether the applicants have complied with the eligibility criterion, documentation requirements for online claim for transport subsidy in case of short term proposal and basic eligibility criterion, total project cost, eligible project cost and means of finance in case of long term projects as detailed out in the agenda notes. PMA have shown the relevant supporting documents from the online portal to the members in support of their recommendation.

Applicant had informed that at the time of transportation, it was not mandatory condition, therefore it didn't collect them and now it is unable to reach out to owner of vehicle for getting FASTag/Toll Receipt. It was informed that Ministry has relaxed the requirement of FASTag/Toll Receipt for Transportation done before 27.08.2020.

PMA informed that except of the FASTag/Toll Receipts, the applicant has submitted all the requisite supporting documents, which PMA examined and found to be in order.

PMA informed that subsidy claimed has been reduced significantly from Rs. 3,81,250 to Rs. 1,59,605 as the claim has been restricted as per Cost Norms for normal truck.

Applicant informed that it has transported the fresh onion from Nashik to Thane in reefer van. In this regard, it was mentioned that this matter has already been clarified in the FAQ, available in the Ministry's website that only transportation in normal truck to be consider for transportation of fresh onion.

Applicant further informed that all the transportation was undertaken from same origin place to the same destination (Port) place and requested to consider the distance claimed by it, instead of restricting it with the google map. Mission noted that there is minor difference of 25-30 KM and directed the PMA to consider the distance as claimed by the applicant on the portal for recalculating the subsidy amount.

PMA recommended the proposal is recommended as eligible for transportation subsidy of Rs. 1,84,074.00.

Representative of the applicant attended the WebEx Meeting held on 02.12.2020

PMA (Grant Thornton) informed this proposal was considered in the 22<sup>nd</sup> MOG meeting held on 21.10.2020. The applicant has submitted the proposal for setting up of integrated value chain development project for Onion crop in Nashik Cluster of Maharashtra with total project cost of Rs. 35.97 Cr. and has sought grant-in-aid of Rs. 17.99 Cr. PMA has examined the proposal and recommended it as ineligible on account of non-submission of detailed bank appraisal note and final term loan sanction from bank. The representative of the applicant had submitted that it is expecting to get these documents from bank within 2-week time and therefore sought some time to submit them.

PMA informed that the applicant has submitted the term loan sanction letter dated 10.11.2020 for Rs. 8 crore from M/s Deogiri Nagari Sahakari Bank Ltd, which is signed by its CEO, but the name of signing authority is not mentioned. The applicant has submitted the detail appraisal note from the same bank, which is not dated and also name of authorised signatory was not mentioned. The applicant has submitted that it will get these rectified by the concerned bank.

PMA made the detailed presentation about the proposal. Mission directed the division to get the requisite details from the applicant regarding process flow, justification for investment on each proposed components and submit a note for consideration in the next meeting.

PMA (Grant Thornton) informed this proposal was considered in the 23<sup>rd</sup> MOG meeting held on 19.11.2020. The applicant has submitted request for extension of timeline of the projects till November 2021 and permission to mobilize the equity and unsecured loan in 5 instalments in Tier-2 account. Mission did not recommend the request of PIA for extension of timeline as the existing timeline has not yet expired and directed to PIA to implement the project expeditiously. Regarding equity mobilisation in 5 instalments, Mission directed the PMA to check whether the PIA fulfils the criteria of FPO as per the scheme guideline of Ministry of Agricultural.

PMA informed that it has checked the criteria of FPO as per the scheme guideline of Ministry of Agricultural and found that the PIA does not fulfil with the conditions of guidelines of Ministry of Agriculture.

Mission directed the PIA to mobilize at least 50% of the proposed equity contribution by the promoters immediately and submit the detailed plan for remaining equity mobilization from each promoters and their source of funding for consideration of next meeting.
