**IMPLEMENTATION OF PMKSY**

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the fund allocated and released under central sector umbrella Scheme - Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY), the details thereof;
- (b) the investment made by Government under Agro-Marine Processing and Development of Agro-Processing Clusters (SAMPADA) scheme, the details thereof;
- (c) whether 'SAMPADA' scheme benefitted the farmers or generated employment in agriculture sector, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps being taken by Government to increase processing level and enhance the export of the processed foods?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) The Government of India had approved the Central sector umbrella scheme i.e. SAMPADA – Scheme for Agro-marine processing and Development of Agro-processing Clusters for implementation period 2016-2020 coterminous with the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission cycle. The scheme has been subsequently renamed as ‘Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY)’. Grant-in-aid is provided under various sub-schemes of PMKSY. The details of fund allocation and released under central sector umbrella Scheme - Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) is at **Annexure**.

(c) & (d) Under the PMKSY scheme, total numbers of 3,23,9279 farmers have been benefitted and total number of 9,94,293 man days of employment have been generated.

(e) The Ministry promotes the overall development of food processing sector through implementation of following schemes:

- PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) : to provide financial, technical and business support for setting up/up-gradation of micro food processing enterprises under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan.

- Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY): to support the creation of food processing infrastructure in the country as well as to create effective backward and forward linkages which will help in providing better returns to farmers, creating employment opportunities especially in rural areas, reducing wastage of agricultural produce, increase the processing level and enhancing the export of processed food. PMKSY has following sub-components :
  - Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure (ICC & VAI) Scheme
  - Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC) Scheme
  - Agro Processing Cluster (APC) Scheme
  - Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure (FTL) Scheme
  - Research and Development (R&D) Scheme
  - Operation Green (OG) Scheme
- Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme: To incentivize creation of global food manufacturing champions and improving the visibility of Indian food brands abroad.

These schemes cover all the segments of food processing sector such as micro, small, medium and large food processing units / projects in the country.
