

Minutes of meeting of Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) for the scheme of Cold Chain, Value Addition and Preservation Infrastructure held on 29.08.2017

A meeting of Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) constituted under Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure was held on 29.08.2017 at 3:00 PM under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister, FPI.

2. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

3. Secretary, FPI welcomed the Hon'ble Minister, FPI and other members of the Committee. Thereafter, the IMAC discussed and deliberated each agenda item. Following decisions were taken:

4. **Agenda Item No. A: Action Taken Note on the decisions taken in the previous IMAC meeting held 17.07.2017.**

IMAC noted the actions taken on the decision of the IMAC in its meeting held on 17.07.2017.

5. **Agenda Item No. B: Representations received from the eligible applicants of Uttarakhand State for setting up of Integrated Cold Chain Projects which were subsequently cancelled**

IMAC considered the agenda and took note of the contents of the letter dated 31.03.2017 of Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of Uttarakhand (Horticulture and Silk Department) whereby it was conveyed that pea processing based IQF units in the Uttarakhand State would require approximately 2.3 lakh MT of green peas whereas the production of green peas in the state was 83000 MT as per 2015-16 production data. Director, Horticulture, Govt. of Uttarakhand submitted that State of Uttarakhand is also producing other fruits and vegetables like mango, apple, litchi, guava, beans, pears, cauliflower, okra, etc. in sizeable quantity in addition to peas. Therefore, Ministry may support cold chain projects envisaging processing/value addition of such horticulture crops in the state of Uttarakhand. He also stated that the Uttarakhand Govt. have no objection, if green pea also forms part of raw material for product mix for processing in the cold chain projects, even if, the same is brought from other states and requested the IMAC for sanction of all the eligible projects from the state of Uttarakhand.

IMAC took note of the product mix of each of 5 previously approved proposals that were subsequently cancelled by the IMAC in its meeting held on 21.4.2017 and observed that

only two proposals i.e. M/s. S K Frozen Foods, Nainital and M/s. Shanti Frozen Foods, Udham Singh Nagar have not envisaged green pea as raw material/ product mix. Remaining three proposals have envisaged green peas as one of the component of product mix. In view of this the IMAC decided to seek in writing the views of State Government as conveyed in the meeting for considering the 2 proposals viz M/s S K Frozen Foods and M/s Shanti Frozen Foods subject to availability of vacant slots. It was also decided to seek latest production data of green peas and feasibility of setting up of new cold chain projects envisaging processing of green peas from the Govt. of Uttarakhand to examine the other cold chain projects received from Uttarakhand.

AGENDA PART - I (PMA: IL&FS CDI)

6. Agenda Item No. 1: The proposal of M/s G K Agro Foods for revision in approved grant-in-aid, rectification in facility details and change of location

The proposal relates to soliciting approval of IMAC regarding revision in approved grant-in-aid, rectification in facility details and change of location of M/s G K Agro Foods, Dist.Jalandhar, Punjab

IMAC noted that the project has been awarded 3 marks for land ownership and 2 marks for suitability of land. Now the applicant has informed that he is not getting the CLU for the said land and has submitted request for change in location the details of which have not been furnished. In view of this, IMAC observed that the 5 marks awarded for above mentioned criteria may be disallowed as the applicant is still not in possession of the project land. After deduction of 5 marks the proposal will come down in the merit list at Sl. No. 124 with 59 marks and will become ineligible for financial assistance at present.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

- a) Revision in score from 64 to 59, placing the proposal at serial no. 124 in the merit list and cancelling approval granted vide Ministry's approval letter No. 4-39/2017-Infra (ICC) dated 04.05.2017.

c) Revision in grant-in-aid from Rs. 847.96 lakh to Rs. 943.34 lakh.

7. Agenda item No. 2: Request of M/s Om Oil & Flour Mills for condonation of delay in submission of documents for release of 3rd instalment of grant and change in the project cost & means of finance in respect of their cold chain project at Cuttak (Odisha)

The IMAC noted that Joint site visit has been conducted on 21.07.2017. As per JIT report the cold chain facility is complete and operational. PMA has recommended release of 3rd instalment of grant vide letter dated 09.08.2017. After considering the agenda note and detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

- b) Condoned the delay in submission of documents for release of 3rd and final instalment of grant-in-aid.

8. Agenda item No. 3: The Proposal of M/s Gopaljee Dairy Foods Pvt. Ltd. for change in bank, locations of Milk Chilling Centre along with the change in AMCU locations.

The IMAC noted that the joint site visit has been conducted on 7th, 8th and 9th March, 2017, followed by a re-inspection by JIT on 14th and 15th June, 2017. The unit is found to be operational with main facility, chilling plants, AMCUs and retail outlets. It was

further noted that the PMA has recommended release of 3rd instalment of grant vide letter dated 19.07.2017.

After considering the agenda note and detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

a) Change of locations of the milk chilling centres as follows:

b) Change of lending bank from Kotak Mahindra Bank (formerly known as ING Vyasa Bank Ltd.) to State Bank of India.

9. Agenda Item No. 4: Request of M/s E-Appliances regarding extension of time till September 2017 for completion of project in all aspects.

The IMAC noted that there has been a delay in implementation of project due to not getting approval from the State Government for rock blasting which has still not been granted. However, the promoter had gone ahead with the project implementation with change in design of the project and alternate arrangement of rock cutting. During the meeting the PMA mentioned that the promoter vide email dated 29.08.2017 has now

provided the detailed implementation schedule of the project, along with request letter for extension of time till December, 2017.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the extension of timeline of project till 30th November, 2017.

10. Agenda item No. 5: Request of M/s Aligned Industries, Haryana for consideration of material store (dry warehouse) as eligible component and release of balance amount of grant-in-aid.

IMAC discussed the agenda note and decided that in the case of M/s Aligned Industries, the material store (dry warehouse) may be considered as eligible component as per the applicable scheme guidelines dated 18.03.2010 and the balance amount of grant-in-aid amounting to Rs. 65.44 lakh which was deducted at the time of release of 3rd instalment of grant may be released to the M/s Aligned Industries. It was also decided to review the guidelines pertaining to irradiation projects to allow storage facility as eligible component.

ADDITIONAL AGENDA (IL&FS)

11. Additional Agenda Item No. 1: Proposal of M/s Brij Dairy & Beverages for change of location of milk collection centres and capacities of insulated milk tankers & insulated vans

IMAC considered the agenda item and noted that the Joint inspection of the project has been conducted and project has achieved completion & commenced commercial operations. It was further noted that the PMA has recommended release of 3rd and final instalment of grant.

After detailed deliberations, the IMAC approved the following:

- a)** Final locations of milk collection centres as (i) Village- Chikhalikhurd, Tehsil – Multai, Dist. Betaul, MP (ii) Village-Dulwa, Indore-Harda Highway (NH-59A), Tehsil-Khategaon, Dist. Dewas (MP) and Village-Ari, Tehsil Barghat, Distt. Seoni (MP).

- b)** Final capacities of insulated milk tankers as 2nos. x 9.2 KL, 1x15 KL [total capacity as 33.4 KL].

- c) Final capacities of insulated vans as 5 nos. x 7 KL, 1 no. x 2 KL (total capacity 37 KL). In the approval letter necessary rectification may be made and the word Reefer vans may be replaced with insulated vans.

12. Additional Agenda Item No. 2: Consideration of admissibility of release of 3rd & final instalment of grant to the project of M/s FIL Industries Ltd., Jammu & Kashmir.

In the integrated cold chain project of M/s FIL Industries Ltd., sorting/grading line for apple with capacity of 10 MT/Hr. was the major component with approved basic cost of Rs. 915.84 lakh, based on quotation from M/s MAF Agrobiotic, France submitted alongwith the proposal. Subsequently, the promoter purchased sorting/grading line from M/s Longobardi, Italy, at a cost of Rs. 543.92 lakh with capacity of 15 MT/hr. The promoter has also shown an expenditure of Rs. 380.09 lakh on additional equipments from certain indigenous manufacturers.

IMAC noted that most of the indigenous components were not necessarily required for running a sorting grading line except (i) Water dumping for crates and (ii) Dry Bin filler.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved for recovery of excess amount of grant-in-aid of Rs. 39.75 lakh released to M/s FIL Industries Ltd., J&K along with an interest @ 10% per annum as per scheme guidelines and the condition of Surety Bond furnished along with documents of release of 1st installment of grant. The interest on Rs. 39.75 lakh would be charged from the date of release of 2nd installment of grant till the date of submission of request by promoter.

13. Additional Agenda Item No. 3: Request of M/s Andhra Pradesh State Warehousing Corporation, Nellore, Andhra Pradesh for revision in approved grant-in-aid.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of the IMAC on the request of M/s Andhra Pradesh State Warehousing Corporation for revision of grant in aid.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 1000 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 832.45 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations IMAC approved revision in grant in aid from Rs 832.45 lakh to Rs. 1060.99 lakh in respect of M/s Andhra Pradesh State Warehousing Corporation. (restricted to Rs 1000 lakh).

14. Additional Agenda Item No. 4: Representation of M/s B L Agro Industries Bikaner, Rajasthan for revision in approved grant-in-aid.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of the IMAC on the request of M/s B L Agro Industries for revision of grant in aid.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 453.41 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 487.66 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

- i) Revision in grant in aid from Rs 487.66 lakh to Rs. 453.41 lakh in respect of M/s B L Agro Industries;
- ii) Promoter may be directed to intimate the revised means of finance factoring in the revised grant of Rs. 453.41 lakh, duly certified by the lending bank

15. Additional Agenda Item No. 5: Request of M/s Fortune Dairy Industries Pvt. Ltd for change in Bank and extension of time required for submission of final bank term loan sanction, change in location and revision in approved grant-in-aid.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of IMAC on the request of M/s Fortune Dairy Industries Pvt. Ltd for change in location and extension of time required for submission of final bank term loan sanction, change in location and review of grant calculation.

IMAC was apprised that the applicant was required to submit the final term loan sanction letter within 60 days of issue of approval letter. However, even after lapse of four months, the promoter could not submit the final term loan sanction letter from the Bank of Maharashtra. Now the promoter has informed that it has approached IDBI Bank for sanction of term loan. IDBI bank vide letter dated 10.08.2017 has informed that they have sought certain clarification/documents from promoter, which are awaited. The bank has intimated that a period of 60 working days would be required for carrying out

due diligence for grant of final sanction of term loan to the project. Further, IDBI bank vide letter dated 28.08.2017 has now informed that they would be able to sanction the loan in 15 days subject to approval of delegated authority of Bank.

After detailed deliberations and considering the agenda item IMAC decided to cancel the approval granted to M/s Fortune Dairy Industries Pvt. Ltd on account of non-submission of final bank sanction till date by the applicant.

16. Additional Agenda Item No. 6: Representation of M/s Friends Agro Industries, Bundi, Rajasthan for revision in approved grant-in-aid

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of IMAC for revision of grant in aid in respect of M/s Friends Agro Industries.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 814.74 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 873.69 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations and considering the agenda item IMAC approved the following in respect of M/s Friends Agro Industries:

- i) Revision in grant in aid from Rs 873.69 lakh to Rs. 814.74 lakh
- ii) Promoter may be directed to intimate the revised means of finance factoring in the revised grant of Rs. 814.74 lakh, duly certified by the lending bank

17. Additional Agenda Item No. 7: Representation of M/s Cremica Food Industries Ltd, Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh for change in location of Farm Level Infrastructure (FLI) from Una, Himachal Pradesh to Phillaur, Punjab and review of grant calculation

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of IMAC for revision in grant calculation of M/s Cremica Food Industries Ltd.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 847.41 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 1000 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations and considering the agenda item IMAC approved the following:

- i) Change in location of FLI from Una, Himachal Pradesh to Phillaur, Punjab;
- ii) Revision in grant in aid from Rs 1000 lakh to Rs 847.41 lakh in respect of M/s Cremica Food Industries Ltd.
- iii) Promoter may be directed to intimate the revised means of finance factoring in the revised grant of Rs. 847.41 lakh, duly certified by the lending bank

18. Additional Agenda Item No. 8: Representation of M/s DS Frozen Foods, Pilibhit, Uttar Pradesh for revision in approved grant-in-aid

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of IMAC for revision of grant in aid in respect of M/s DS Frozen Foods.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 754.08 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 709.53 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations and considering the agenda item, IMAC approved the following:

- i) Revision in grant in aid from Rs 709.53 lakh to Rs. 754.08 lakh in respect of M/s DS Frozen Foods.
- ii) Promoter may be directed to intimate the revised means of finance factoring in the revised grant of Rs. 754.08 lakh, duly certified by the lending bank

AGENDA PART II [PMA: Grant Thornton India LLP]

19. Agenda item no. 1: - Proposal for continuation or otherwise of the approval granted to the integrated cold chain project of M/s Paras Spices, Una, Himachal Pradesh.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration of IMAC regarding continuation or otherwise of the approval granted to the integrated cold chain project of M/s Paras Spices, Una, Himachal Pradesh.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC noted that the newly formed entity i.e. M/s BS Paras Spices Cold Chain Pvt. Ltd. is not meeting the net worth eligibility criterion required as per scheme guidelines and hence, IMAC cancelled the approval granted to the Integrated Cold Chain Project of M/s Paras Spices, Una, Himachal Pradesh.

20. Agenda Item No. 2: - Request of promoter for extension of timeline for completion of cold chain project and submission of documents for release of 3rd installment in respect of M/s Mahua Cooperative Cold Storage Ltd., Vaishali, Bihar.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and approval of IMAC for extension of timeline upto 31.10.2017 for completion of integrated cold chain project and submission of documents for release of 3rd and final installment of grant to M/s Mahua Cooperative Cold Storage Ltd., Vaishali, Bihar.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the request of the promoter for extension of timeline upto 31.10.2017 for completion of cold chain project and submission of documents for release of 3rd installment. IMAC further decided that no further extension of time will be granted and the project will be closed for further financial assistance in case of non-submission of documents within the extended timelines.

21. Agenda Item No. 3: - Information regarding utilization of already released grant-in-aid and financial closure of the approval granted to the integrated cold chain project of M/s Transport Corporation of India Ltd., Gurgaon, Haryana – reg.

IMAC took note of the agenda item and approved the financial closure of the approval granted to the integrated cold chain project of M/s Transport Corporation of India Ltd., Gurgaon, Haryana.

22. Agenda item No. 4: - Continuation or otherwise of the approval granted to M/s Prithvi Multi-Purpose Cold Storage Private Limited for setting up of Integrated Cold Chain project at Mouza - Dadpur, P.S. - Amdanga, District-24 Parganas (North) West Bengal.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration and directions of IMAC regarding continuation or otherwise of the approval granted to M/s Prithvi Multi-Purpose Cold Storage Private Limited for setting up of Integrated Cold Chain project at Mouza - Dadpur, P.S. - Amdanga, District-24 Parganas (North) West Bengal with financial assistance of Ministry of Food Processing Industries.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC noted that the Ministry had approved the integrated cold chain project of M/s Prithvi Multi-Purpose Cold Storage Private Limited, West Bengal on 28.05.2015 for grant of Rs. 10 crore. IMAC noted that the two year period for completion of the project has already expired on 27.05.2017 and the promoter has failed to submit the proper requisite documents for release of 1st installment of grant-in-aid despite repeated efforts of PMA & the Ministry. Further, the IMAC was apprised that lending bank of the project i.e. United Bank of India, Kasba Branch, Kolkata vide letter dated 24.08.2017 has conveyed that the term loan account for the project has turned NPA(Non-performing assets). After considering all facts and circumstances of the case, IMAC decided to cancel the approval granted to the Integrated Cold Chain Project of M/s Prithvi Multi-Purpose Cold Storage Private Limited, West Bengal.

23. Agenda Item No. 5: - Request for Change in location of one Distribution Hub /Minimal Processing Centre, merger of three Distribution Hubs/Minimal Processing Centers & shifting of same to new location and extension of time in respect of Cold Chain Project of M/s SKM Animal Feeds and Foods (India) Limited

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration of IMAC on request of promoter for change of location of one Distribution hub /Minimal Processing Centre from Malapuram to Calicut, merger of capacity of 3 locations of Distribution Hub/MPC viz 1). Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, 2). Tuticorin, Tamilnadu and 3). Ernakulum, Kerela to new proposed location at SKM Chicken Plant at Dindigul,Tamil Nadu and extension of timeline for completion of the integrated cold chain project.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

- i. Change in location of one Distribution Hub /Minimal Processing Centre from Malapuram, Kerala (Cold Storage-250 MT) to Calicut (Kozhikode), Kerala (Cold Storage-250 MT).
- ii. Did not accede to the request of merger of 3 Locations of Distribution Hubs /Minimal Processing Centre viz (i) Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala (ii) Tuticorin, Tamilnadu, (iii) Ernakulam, Kerala with Cold storage [250 MT each] to new proposed location at SKM Chicken Processing Plant at S.F.No 110/3A and 114 Athimarathuvala, Rajampatti Post, Palani Taluk, Dindigul District [Cold storage - 750 MT].
- iii. Joint inspection of the project may be carried out to ascertain the status of implementation and the grant may be recalculated based on joint inspection and the matter may be placed before the IMAC again for consideration and decision.

24. Agenda Item No. 6: - Request of promoter for revision in grant, correction in capacity of road milk tanker and extension of time for submission of documents in compliance of 60 days' requirement as per approval letter in respect of M/s Mehsana Dairy & Food Products Ltd., Gujarat.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration of IMAC on request of promoter for revision in grant, correction in capacity of road milk tanker and extension of time for submission of documents in compliance of 60 days requirement as per approval letter in respect of cold chain project of M/s Mehsana Dairy & Food Products Ltd., Gujarat.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 1000 lakh against previously approved grant of Rs 992.15 lakh. The revised grant calculation as annexed with the agenda shall be conveyed to the promoter.

After detailed deliberations, IMAC approved the following:

- i. Revision in grant-in-aid from Rs. 992.15 lakh to Rs. 1086.83 lakh [restricted to Rs. 1000.00 lakh]
- ii. Revision in capacity of road milk tanker from 2 nos. x 2 KL to 2 nos. x 20 KL; and
- iii. Condonation for delay in submission of documents in compliance of 60 days requirements of approval letter. Further, IMAC directed that no extension in over all timeline will be granted for completing the project.

25. Agenda Item No. 7: - Request of promoter for revision of grant-in-aid and correction in capacities of facilities in respect of M/s Nokha Agrotech Pvt. Ltd., Bikaner, Rajasthan.

The proposal relates to soliciting consideration of IMAC regarding revision of grant-in-aid and correction in capacities of facilities in respect of M/s Nokha Agrotech Pvt. Ltd., Bikaner, Rajasthan.

IMAC noted that Cold Chain Division while processing the request of the promoter for upward revision of grant has reviewed the grant calculation as per the scheme guidelines and cost norms and accordingly recalculated the grant at Rs 766.18 lakh
