

**Minutes of IMAC meeting held on 05.05.2022 under the
Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure**

The meeting of Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister (FPI) in the presence of Hon'ble MoS(FPI) and the Secretary(FPI) along with other Members of the IMAC.

2. A total of 36 agenda Items were discussed as per the Agenda circulated.

13.	M/s Indus Farmer Food Araria, Bihar	IMAC decided that the project is ineligible as the promoter has deferred his plan for implementing this project.

4. IMAC approved that the approval letters in r/o projects found eligible may be issued and their promoters be advised to make all out efforts to implement the projects within the prescribed timelines.

5. IMAC also decided that in case of IMAC grants Extension of time and Condonation of delay than the usual penalty with stipulation that waiver for penalty be allowed only for the two months for disruption due to the second wave of Covid in 2021 may be granted.
