

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE INTER - MINISTERIAL APPROVAL COMMITTEE (IMAC) CONSTITUTED UNDER THE SCHEME FOR INTEGRATED COLD CHAIN AND VALUE ADDITION INFRASTRUCTURE HELD ON 20.08.2018

In continuation of IMAC meeting held on 18.08.2018, a meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) constituted under the Scheme of Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure was held under the Chairpersonship of Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 20.08.2018 to consider the proposals received against the EOI dated 10.03.2018 for grant of financial assistance. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

2. Shri Parag Gupta, Joint Secretary & Convener of IMAC welcomed the Hon'ble Minister and other members of the Committee. IMAC considered 30 proposals pertaining to Fruits & Vegetables sector from states of Chattisgarh, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh & Uttarakhand and reviewed the recommendations made by the Technical Committee against each proposal.

3. The applicants were also invited to the IMAC meeting. The applicants or representatives of the proposals presented their case before IMAC and the eligibility criteria, marks obtained against each criteria & eligible grant were informed to them. The submissions/clarifications, if any, made by the applicants based on the interaction, have been factored into the final decision of the IMAC.

4. Based on the deliberations, IMAC approved 13 proposals as eligible. Details of the eligible proposals along with grant is at **Annexure-II**. IMAC rejected 17 proposals as in-eligible as per **Annexure-III**.

5. Other decisions

- a. IMAC directed that in future EoIs no second proposal shall be entertained from the existing promoter(s) who have availed grant-in-aid under the Scheme for Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure.
- b. IMAC observed that Ministry has already sanctioned a significant number of projects in the states of Maharashtra, Uttarakhand, Andhra Pradesh & Gujarat in different phases. In the present EoI, Ministry has received significant number of proposals from the aforementioned states. IMAC directed to write to the States of Maharashtra, Uttarakhand, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat with respect to availability of sufficient raw material within the state for capacity utilization and successful commercial operation of the proposals received against the EoI dated 10.03.2018.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and all present.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018 and 31.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with the score of 80, total project cost of Rs. 9300.89 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs. 1736.43 lakh (Restricted to Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines).

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 80 out of 94 marks (85.11 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 9300.89 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs. 1736.43 lakh (Restricted to Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines).

2. Phoenix Frozen Foods, Anand, Gujarat

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with score of 67, total project cost of Rs. 2269.00 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs.890.47 lakh (Restricted to the grant sought amount of Rs. 802.00 lakh)

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 67 out of 94 marks (71.28 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 2269.00 lakh and eligible grant of Rs.890.47 lakh (Restricted to the grant sought amount of Rs. 802.00 lakh).

3. Om CA Store (A unit of Om Hospitalities and Resorts), Solan, Himachal Pradesh

Shri. Amit Sahni, partner of the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with score of 76, total project cost of Rs. 1499.50 lakh and grant amount of Rs. 956.16 lakh.

IMAC reviewed the scoring criterion & revised the score as follows:

a. Scoring Criterion No. 4. Backward Forward Linkages:

IMAC in its meeting held on 28.08.2018 decided to award the marks against the evaluation criteria no. 4 relating to Backward Forward Linkages, if the applicant has submitted the backward linkage agreement even with individual farmer/ producer in case of F&V and Marine/Fishery/Meat Sector. Accordingly, 5 marks are awarded under this scoring criterion considering that the applicant has submitted 16 agreements signed with different farmers in support of backward linkages and the score is revised from 5 to 10 marks in criterion no.4.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 81 out of 94 marks (86.17 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 1499.50 lakh and eligible grant of Rs. 956.16 Lakh.

4. Anand Foods, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand

No representative from the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07. 2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC with a score of 75, total project cost of Rs. 2313.80 lakh and eligible grant of Rs. 1124.46 lakh [Restricted to Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 75 out of 94 marks (79.79 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 2313.80 lakh and eligible grant of Rs. 1124.46 lakh [Restricted to Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

5. Anglian Infrastructure Development Pvt. Ltd, Kanchipuram, Tamil Nadu

Shri Sanjay Sharma & Shri. Ashish Singhal from the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with score of 61, total project cost Rs. 3133.03 lakh & eligible grant of Rs. 591.78 lakh.

IMAC reviewed the scoring criterion & revised the score as follows:

a. Scoring Criterion No. 4. Backward Forward Linkages:

IMAC in its meeting held on 28.08.2018 decided to award the marks against the evaluation criteria no. 4 relating to Backward Forward Linkages, if the applicant has submitted the backward linkage agreement even with individual farmer/ producer in case of F&V and Marine/Fishery/Meat Sector. Accordingly, 5 marks are awarded under this scoring criterion considering that the applicant has submitted 10 agreements signed with different farmers in support of backward linkages and the score is revised from 0 to 5 marks in criterion no.4.

b. Scoring Criterion No. 9. Project Proposed to be set up in less covered states:

IMAC decided to remove the scoring criteria of less covered state and accordingly, the score against this criterion was revised from 6 to 0.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with score of 60 out of 94 marks (63.83 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost Rs. 3133.03 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs.591.78 lakh.

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1. PEP Foods, Gandhinagar, Gujarat

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 17th July 2018, 31st July 2018, 13th Aug 2018 and TC recommended that the proposal to be placed before IMAC with a score of 71, total project cost of Rs. 2691.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 1026.03 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

IMAC observed that applicant had not mentioned/ identified location of farm level infrastructure. However, applicant had proposed processing unit at farm level. Thus, project was approved on merit of the proposal.

IMAC reviewed the scoring criterion & revised the score as follows:

a. Scoring Criterion No. 4. Backward Forward Linkages:

IMAC in its meeting held on 28.08.2018 decided to award the marks against the evaluation criteria no. 4 relating to Backward Forward Linkages, if the applicant has submitted the backward linkage agreement even with individual farmer/ producer in case of F&V and Marine/Fishery/Meat Sector. Accordingly, 5 marks are awarded under this scoring criterion considering that the applicant has submitted 16 agreements signed with different farmers in support of backward linkages and the score is revised from 5 to 10 marks in criterion no.4.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a revised score of 76 out of 94 (80.85 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 2691.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 1026.03 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

2. Dev Bhumi Cold Chain Private Limited, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27th July 2018. TC recommended that the proposal to be placed before IMAC with a score of 81, total project cost of Rs. 1904.00 Lakh and grant of Rs. 949.80 Lakh.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC with a score of 81 out of 94 (86.17 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 1904.00 Lakh and grant of Rs. 949.80 Lakh.

3. Hitech Food Process, Bijapur, Karnataka

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 5th July 2018. TC recommended that the proposal to be placed before IMAC with a score of 69, total project cost of Rs. 1500.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 862.43 Lakh.

Mr. Ulaveesh Kumar represented that full marks should be given to as applicant had submitted latest data for district wise fruits and vegetables production. However, it was noted that applicant had submitted district wise fruits and vegetables production which did not match with latest data. Thus, IMAC did not revise the score of applicant in raw material availability criteria.

It was brought to the notice of IMAC that the applicant has been sanctioned a project under backward forward linkages scheme recently in the name of "Agri Process" and in this regard the applicant vide letter dated 4th August 2018 has submitted that his first choice would be to implement the project of Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure Facilities.

IMAC reviewed the scoring criteria and revised the score as follows:

a. Scoring Criterion No. 4. Backward Forward Linkages:

IMAC in its meeting held on 28.08.2018 decided to award the marks against the evaluation criteria no. 4 relating to Backward Forward Linkages, if the applicant has submitted the backward linkage agreement even with individual farmer/ producer in case of F&V and Marine/Fishery/Meat Sector. Accordingly, 5 marks are awarded under this scoring criterion considering that the applicant has submitted 16 agreements signed with different farmers in support of backward linkages and the score is revised from 4 to 9 marks in criterion no.4.

b. Scoring criterion # 9 Project proposed to be set up in less covered states: IMAC removed the scoring criteria for all the proposals. Subsequently, the score was revised from 6 to 0.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a revised score of 68 out of 94 (72.34 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 1500.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 862.43 Lakh.

4. Shri Ram Solvent Extractions Pvt Ltd, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20th July 2018 and TC recommended that the proposal to be placed before IMAC with a score of 75, total project cost of Rs. 1265.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 852.39 Lakh.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC with a score of 75 out of 94 (79.79 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 1265.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 852.39 Lakh.

Shri Rakesh Ahuja, proprietor of the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with the score of 70, total project cost of Rs.1694.35 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs. 990.84 lakh.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 70 out of 94 marks (74.47 marks out of 100 marks), total project cost of Rs. 1694.35 lakh and grant of Rs.990.84 lakh.

2. Raj Frozen Products, Jalaun, Uttar Pradesh

Shri Samsuddin Rayeen, partner of the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with a score of 78, total project cost of Rs.2353.00 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs.913.15 lakh.

IMAC reviewed the scoring criteria and revised the score as follows:

- a. Scoring Criterion, No 9. Project Proposed to be set up in less covered states-**IMAC deducted 6 marks under the criteria No. 9 i.e. Project Proposed to be set up in less covered states. Accordingly, IMAC revised the scoring from 6 to 0 marks in criterion no. 9 of Scoring.

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a revised score of 72 out of 94 marks (76.60 marks out of 100 marks), total project of Rs. 2353.00 lakh and grant of Rs. 913.15 lakh.

3. Anand Frozen Foods, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand

Representative of the applicant firm has not attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with the score of 74, total project cost of Rs. 689.98 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs. 372.56 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 350.00 lakh as sought by the applicant].

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 74 out of 94 marks (78.72 marks out of 100 marks) and grant of Rs. 372.56 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 350.00 lakh as sought by the applicant].

4. Jai Kissan Foods, Udham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand

Representative of the applicant firm has not attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as eligible with the score of 69, total project cost of Rs.2301.04 lakh and eligible grant in aid of Rs. 1058.14 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

IMAC approved the proposal as eligible with a score of 69 out of 94 marks (73.40 marks out of 100 marks) and grant of Rs. 1058.14 lakh [Restricted at Rs. 1000.00 lakh as per scheme guidelines].

1. Canvas Integrated Cold Chain Services, Una, Himachal Pradesh

Shri Subhash Rawat, Manager of the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018 and 31.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria as per scheme guidelines:

- i. The combined net worth of the partnership firm (as per balance sheet dated 31.03.2018) and the promoters (as ascertained based on CA certificate and supporting documents) is Rs. 932.36 lakhs only which is less than the required Rs.1440.00 lakh (1.5 times the grant sought by the applicant Rs.960.00 lakh) for consideration.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of insufficient net worth.

2. Shivshankar Food Process and Cold Chain, Gadak, Karanataka

No representative from the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018 and 31.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria as per the scheme guidelines:

- i. The net worth of the applicant as per the CA certificate is Rs. 875.74 lakh. However, the total net worth of the applicant based on the supporting documents that have been uploaded is only Rs. 119.91 lakh against the required amount of Rs. 750.00 lakh (1.5 times of grant sought amount of Rs. 500.00 lakh).
- ii. The applicant has uploaded an incomplete bank appraisal note and the undertaking provided by the applicant is also incomplete.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of insufficient net worth.

3. Infra Fine Foods Private Limited, Dharwad, Karnataka

Shri Prakash Kanoor & Shri. Pradeep Kanoor, promoters of the applicant company attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 20.07.2018 and 31.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria:

- i. The net worth of the applicant company, M/s. Infra Fine Foods Private Limited as per the CA certificate is Rs. 499.58 lakh as on 23.05.2018. However, net worth as per the uploaded audited balance sheet as at 31st March 2017 of the applicant company is only Rs. 99.49 lakh which is less than the required net worth of Rs.750.00 lakh (1.5 times of grant sought amount of Rs. 500.00 lakh) for eligibility.
- ii. The applicant has not uploaded the bank appraisal note for the proposed project.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of insufficient net worth and also in not uploading the bank appraisal note.

4. Royal Foodstuffs Private Limited, Satara, Maharashtra

Shri Ankit Sakkargi, promoter of the applicant company attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 05.07.2018 and 31.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria:

- i. Expansion of existing unit (at plot D-21/22) without a new Technical Civil Work (as clarified by the promoter during the TC meeting). Further, based on only the new standalone cold storage proposed at separate location, the proposal becomes in-eligible as per the scheme guidelines

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria of the scheme guidelines.

5. Kamal Industries, Sangareddy, Telangana

No representative from the applicant firm attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 27.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria:

- i. The applicant has envisaged a "Multiproduct cold store with insulated van" only. Accordingly, the proposed components do not meet the component wise eligibility of the scheme guidelines (*i.e. to avail financial assistance under this scheme, the applicant will have to set up Farm Level Infrastructure as mentioned at 4(a) of the guidelines and any one or both of the components from 4 (b) and 4 (c) of the guidelines*).
- ii. The applicant has availed financial assistance from MoFPI earlier as Grant in-aid to M/s Kamal Industries, Belur industrial, area, Dharwar, Karnataka vide F. No. 4-36/2014-F&VP for an amount of Rs. 50 Lakhs. As confirmed by the concerned Division, the date

of release of last instalment of previous availed grant is 16.03.2017 which does not meet the eligibility criteria as per the scheme guidelines

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of the proposal being stand-alone cold store without any value addition.

6. B.B foods Pvt. Ltd, Agra, Uttar Pradesh

Shri Manesh Aggarwal, promoter of the applicant company attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 05.07.2018. TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria of the scheme guidelines:

- i. The applicant company has not proposed any new civil work for the expansion proposal which is not as per the eligibility criteria as per clause 8. (n) of the scheme guidelines.
- ii. The catchment area proposed for the proposal is at a distance of 40 km from the FLI and so the proposed location may not be treated as an FLI as per the clause 4 (a) of the guidelines.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria of the scheme guidelines.

7. Sunvita Foods Private Limited, Bulandsahar, Uttar Pradesh

Ms. Deepti from the applicant company attended the IMAC meeting held on 20.08.2018.

IMAC noted that the proposal was considered in TC meeting held on 05.07.2018 and TC has recommended the proposal to be placed before IMAC as ineligible on account of not meeting the following basic eligibility criteria of the scheme guidelines:

- i. The net worth supporting CA certificate along with the supporting documents in name of the applicant entity have not been uploaded.
- ii. The Bank Appraisal note from the lending bank for the proposed project has not been uploaded.

IMAC approved the recommendation of the TC and rejected the proposal on account of not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria of the scheme guidelines.
