Ministry of Food Processing Industries- Report for January, 2020

1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1.1 Important policy decision taken during the month: Nil.

1.2 Major achievements during the month:

A. Mega Food Park:

a. Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMAC) chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 06.01.2020 for considering the progress of implementation of Mega Food Parks and requests of SPVs/IAs for revision in SSA/extension of timeline etc.

b. A Mega Food Park project in Thoubal district of Manipur was accorded final approval on 30.01.2020.

B. Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (Unit Scheme):

a. The guidelines of the Scheme of Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities have been further amended and notified on website of Ministry on 08.01.2020. The date of Expression of Interest (EOI) has been extended up to 31.03.2020 for inviting proposals under the scheme.

C. Cold Chain Scheme:

a. During this month, nine (9) cold chain project has reported completion and start of commercial operations. Total no. of projects completed under the scheme is 192.

b. Expression of Interest (EOI) had been issued on 29.01.2020 for inviting proposals for setting up of Cold Chain projects under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana. The last date for receipt of proposals is 13.03.2020.

D. Operation Greens:

a. 13th Mission Meeting was held on 27.01.2020 to consider six (6) proposals, out of which 3 proposals were found to be eligible and to make its recommendations to the Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC).

E. IIFPT:

a. Two days training programme was conducted for 40 farmers (ATMA-Sankarankoil) on "Post-Harvest Management and Supply Management" on 08.01.2020 and 09.01.2020.

b. IIFPT signed Memorandum of Understanding with eight national institutions- PAU-Ludhiana, MRS Punjab Technical University-Bathinda, NDRI-Karnal, SLIET-Sangrur, CIPHET-Ludhiana, IIWBR_Karnal, NABI-Mohali, Guru Nanak College, Budhlada, in the presence of Smt. Harsimrat Kaur Badal, Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 13.01.2020 at Bathinda, Punjab.

c. MS. Rita Teotia, Chairperson, FSSAI inaugurated the Food Testing & Training Centre and Awareness Campaign on "Eat Right India" on 30.01.2020 at IIFPT.

d. IIFPT entered into MoA with Brihadeeswara Big Temple-Thanjavur, Punnainallur Mariamman Temple-Arulmolipet and Shri Shirdi Sai Baba Trust-Thanjavur to provide guidance on good manufacturing practices of prasadam under the BHOG scheme of FSSAI.

F. NIFTEM:

a. Japanese delegation visited NIFTEM on 21.01.2020.

b. Skill development programme was organized for trainers in NIFTEM for from 20.01.2020 & 21.01.2020. Nine (9) participants (2 females & 7 males) participated.

c. 20th Finance Committee meeting was organized on 20.01.2020 at New Delhi.

G. Food Safety & Quality Assurance Infrastructure:

a. During this month, two (2) Food Testing Laboratories reported completion and start of commercial operations.

1.3 Foreign visit of Hon'ble Minister, FPI and foreign delegation to MoFPI:

a. A bilateral meeting was held between Ms. Tereza Cristina Correa da Costa Dias, Minister of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply, Brazil with Smt. Harsimrat Kaur Badal, Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 22.01.2020.

b. As a follow up meeting of above, a meeting was held on 27.01.2020 between the Brazilian Association of Animal Protein with Indian Industry Delegation Under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, FPI on important policy matter.
