## **Ministry of Food Processing Industries – Report for June, 2019**

### **1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

#### **A. Gram SAMRIDHI Yojana**

The meeting of the Expenditure Finance Committee chaired by Secretary, Expenditure to consider the proposal on implementation of a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme-“India Food Processing and Value Addition Program for Unorganised Sector-Gram SAMRIDHI Yojana” was held 07.06.2019. The Committee has recommended the scheme at total cost of Rs.3000 crore (World Bank share: Rs.1500 crore; Gol share: Rs.900 crore; States share: Rs. 600 crore) with an indicative outlay of Rs.245 crore for FY 2019-20. Draft CCEA Note has been formulated and referred to the Department of Expenditure on 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2019 for obtaining approval of Finance Minister..

#### **B. Operation Greens:**

i) Two Mission Operation Greens meeting was held on 10.06.2019 & 26.06.2019 under chairmanship of Joint Secretary, FPI to consider the representation made by the applicants, to review the status regarding prevailing price situation for TOP crops & to consider 6 number of proposals for setting up of integrated value chain development projects.

ii) Memorandum of Agreement was signed with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Project Management Agency (PMA) i.e. M/s Nabcons Consultancy Service Pvt. Ltd (M/s NABCONS) for award of contract to work as PMA under Operation Greens Scheme.

iii) Two Road-shows for promoting the scheme was organized at Gadag and Kolar in Karnataka on 03.06.2019 and 04.06.2019 in collaboration with Karnataka State Horticulture Department.

### **C. Cold Chain:**

i) IMAC meetings on Cold Chain Scheme were held under the chairpersonship of Minister (FPI) on 12/06/2019, 13/06/2019 & 14/06/2019. 19 proposals were approved in the meeting.

ii) During the month, under the scheme of Integrated Cold Chain & Value Addition Infrastructure of PMKSY, two (2) cold chain projects have reported completion and start of commercial operations. Total number of projects completed under the scheme is 154.

### **D. Scheme for Agro-processing Clusters:**

i) Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) Chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 18-06-2019 for considering the proposals received under the Scheme for Creation of Infrastructure for Agro Processing Clusters under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) approved four (04) Agro Processing Clusters in various states of the country. The projects will leverage Rs.101.64 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 33.00 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 784.29 crore.

### **E. Creation/ Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Scheme:**

i) Two Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) meetings were held under the chairpersonship by Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 20-06-2019 & 21.06.2019 for considering the proposals received under the Scheme of Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) and twenty-seven (27) Food Processing units were approved in various states of the country. The projects will leverage Rs.166.62 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 75.56 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 1916.48 crore.

**F. Mega Food Park:**

i) Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) Chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI was held on 16-06-2019 for considering the progress of implementation of Mega Food Parks and to consider the requests of SPVs/IV for revision of SSA/ extension of timeline etc.

**G. IIFPT:**

i) Shri Rameswar Teli, Hon'ble Minister of State, FPI was the chief Guest at the National Conference on emerging techniques in Food Processing held from 27<sup>th</sup> -28<sup>th</sup> June, 2019.

ii) Hon'ble MoS, FPI inaugurated the Computational Modelling and Nanoscale Processing Unit at IIFPT on 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2019.

iii) IIFPT celebrated 1<sup>st</sup> World Food Safety Day at IIFPT on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2019.

i) 12<sup>th</sup> Planning & Monitoring meeting was held on 26.06.2019.

ii) A workshop on Research Methodology and Research publication was been organized from 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June at NIFTEM Campus.

2.1 International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2019. Hon'ble Minister of State, FPI led the yoga session in the premises of MoFPI. Essay Competition were also organized during yoga day.
