As per the instructions contained in Cabinet Secretary's ID. No. 601/2/1/2014 (Vol.III)-TS dated 28.04.2016, I am sending herewith a report of the initiatives taken by the Ministry during the month of December, 2022 for your kind perusal.

2. D/o Expenditure has conveyed approval of Cabinet Secretary for organising the Mega Food Event at ITPO, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi for the expenditure of Rs. 56.31 Crores. Hon'ble Minister, FPI reviewed the plan of actions Mega Food Event 2023 on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022. Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) is going ahead with planning of the event that is proposed to be held on 3rd - 5th of November, 2023. The event will give focus to millets along with other food products.

3. Under Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC) Scheme under PMKSY, 198 projects have been approved by Project Approval Committee (PAC) in its meeting held on 21.12.2022 under the chairmanship of Minister, FPI. The proposals received were for a total project cost of Rs. 4366.13 crore involving grant-in-aid of Rs. 755.69 crore and leveraging investment of Rs. 3610.44 crore against Expression of Interest (EoI) dated 21.06.2022. However, with limited funds available under the Scheme, only 33 out of 198 projects were approved by the PAC.

4. Under the Cold Chain Scheme, 24 projects were approved by the PAC with a project cost of Rs. 1160.62 crore involving grant-in-aid of Rs. 179.75 crore.

5. Similarly, 21 projects under the Agro Processing Clusters scheme were approved by PAC with a project cost of Rs. 714.56 crore involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 196 crore.

6. Under Operation Greens scheme, 46 projects were approved by the PAC with a project cost of Rs. 2218.69 crore involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 466.66 crore

7. Under the Production Linked Incentive Scheme, the first claim of Rs. 107.33 crore has been disbursed and further claims have been received which are under verification.

## **Ministry of Food Processing Industries - Report for December, 2022**

1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1.1 Major achievements during the month:

### **A. Aatmanirbhar Bharat:**

#### **a. Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME): -**

Various actions taken/developments in the month of December, 2022 in the implementation of the Scheme are as under:

##### **a1. Implementation Status: -**

- **Progress on Individual Applications:** 11,934 individual applications were submitted and 2936 loans were sanctioned. Central share of subsidy of Rs. 31.50 crore was released to 1231 beneficiaries.
- **Capacity Building:** 3910 Beneficiaries were trained in 26 States/ UTs, 160 DLTs and 40 DRPs trained under EDP and ODOP.
- **Seed Capital:**
- **National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM):** Rs. 0.82 crore was released for 679 urban SHG members.

##### **a2. Promotional Activities:**

- 198 Online Webinars / Offline Workshops/ Exhibitions/ Stakeholder Meetings conducted under PMFME Scheme with media coverage, 1 success story of PMFME Scheme Beneficiaries published under 'Kahaani Sukshma Udyamon Ki Series' under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.
- 429 Social media posts shared via PMFME Facebook Page and Twitter Handle. 2560 Followers on PMFME Twitter Handle, 3306 Followers on Facebook Page. Participation of PMFME Scheme beneficiaries from Rajasthan, Sikkim, Uttarakhand, Karnataka, Delhi, Maharashtra, Haryana, Ladakh, Madhya Pradesh and Punjab at SIAL India 2022.

##### **Meetings:**

- PMFME Review Meeting held on 13.12.2022 and 27.12.2022 under Chairmanship of Additional Secretary, FPI.
- Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Additional Secretary, FPI at 12:30 PM on 14th December 2022, with NAFED to review the phase 1 of the Branding and Marketing Proposal under the PMFME Scheme.

### **B. Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Food Processing Industry:**

- First claim of Rs. 107.325 crore was disbursed under PLI Scheme.
- Stakeholders' Consultation was held on 19.12.2022 to deliberate upon proposed new PLI Scheme for Nutraceuticals.

## **C. Progress under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojna (PMKSY):**

### **C-1. Creation / Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC):**

- A meeting of Project Approval Committee (PAC) was held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 21.12.2022 for considering proposals received against Expression of Interest (EoI) dated 21.06.2022. 198 projects were approved by the PAC subject to availability of funds and vacant slots under the category with total project cost of Rs. 4366.13 Cr. involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 755.69 crore leverage investment of Rs. 3610.44 crore. However, with the present funds available under the Scheme, only for 33 out of 198 projects approved by PAC, can be sanctioned and remaining 165 projects cannot be sanctioned for grants-in-aid presently, as sufficient funds are not available.

### **C-2 Cold Chain:**

- A total number of 24 projects in Cold Chain have been approved by PAC with total project cost of Rs. 1160.62 Cr. involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 179.75 Cr.

### **C-3 Operation Greens:**

- A total number of 46 projects have been approved by PAC with total project cost of Rs. 2218.69 Cr. involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 466.66 Cr.

### **C-4 Scheme for Creation of Infrastructure for Agro- Processing Clusters:**

- A total number of 21 projects have been approved by PAC with total project cost of Rs. 714.56 Cr. involving grants-in-aid of Rs. 196 Cr.

### **C-5 Mega Food Park:**

- Two review meeting regarding status of Mega Food Park projects were held under the Chairmanship of the Additional Secretary, FPI on 22.12.2022 & 27.12.2022.

### **C-6 Mega Food Event 2023:**

- D/o Expenditure has conveyed approval of Cabinet Secretary for organising the Mega Food Event at ITPO, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi in 2023 for the expenditure of Rs.56.31 Crores.
- Round table interactions were held under the chairpersonship of Secretary FPI, to appraise them about the upcoming Mega Food Event 2023 held-
  - Resident Commissioners (8<sup>th</sup> December 2022) at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi
  - Central Ministries and Departments (15<sup>th</sup> December 2022); at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi
  - Senior Officials of Northeast (27<sup>th</sup> December 2022) at Guwahati, Assam.

- Meeting was held on 28.12.2022 between Additional Secretary, MoFPI and Foreign Ambassadors (HE Ambassador of **Malaysia** and HE Ambassador of **Myanmar**) to appraise them about the upcoming Mega Food Event-2023.
- Review of Plan of actions for IYOM and upcoming Mega Food Event 2023 was held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister FPI on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022.
- Review meetings are being held under the chairpersonship of Secretary, FPI to track progress of activities on alternate days in a week.
- The bid for selection of Event Partner for organising Mega Food Event-2023 opened on 05.12.2022 and is on Final Stage for awarding of the contract.
