- 1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:
- 1.1 Important policy decision taken during the month:

Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance communicated to the Ministry on 01.02.2022 that the Cabinet has approved continuation of the central sector umbrella scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) with an allocation of Rs. 4600 Cores till 31.03.2026 or till further review, whichever is earlier.
