Dear Sir,

As per the instructions contained in Cabinet Secretary's ID. No. 601/2/1/2014 (Vol.III)-TS dated 28.04.2016, I am sending herewith a report of the initiatives taken by the Ministry during the month of June, 2022 for your kind perusal.

2. The Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) is an old scheme of the Ministry which has been given an approval for continuation under the 15th Finance Commission duration in January, 2022. The guidelines pertaining to various sub-schemes under the PMKSY were framed during the year December 2019 to March 2021 which were examined in totality in order to remove any difficulties for the beneficiary promoters. The guidelines have been modified to the suit the present times after intensive consultation with the stakeholders in order to reduce compliance burden. The modified guidelines have been notified on 08.06.2022 and thereafter Expression of Interest (EoI) for inviting proposals on component schemes of PMKSY have been notified on 27.06.2022. It is anticipated that by 10.08.2022, which is the last date of application, we will be receiving adequate number of proposals.

3. The Production Linked Incentive (PLI) for millets based products under the Ready-to-Eat (RTE), Ready to Cook (RTC) category was recommended by the Empowered Group of Secretaries for PLI on 09.06.2022 and after taking approval from the competent authority, EoI for PLI under Millets and organic products has been floated on 27.06.2022.

Ministry of Food Processing Industries - Report for June, 2022

1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1.1 Major achievements during the month:

A. Aatmanirbhar Bharat:

a. Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME): -

Various actions taken/developments in the month of June, 2022 in the implementation of the Scheme are as under:

a1. Implementation Status: -

- **One District One Product (ODOP):**
- ODOP approved for 2 new districts of Sikkim – Pakyong and Soreng during the month.

- **Capacity Building:** 148 Beneficiaries were trained in 13 States / UTs during the month.

- **Seed Capital:**

- **National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM):** 1937 SHG members have been recommended by State Rural Livelihood Mission (SRLM) to State Nodal Agency (SNA) for seed capital of Rs. 6.92 crore. Rs. 1.89 crore was released to 609 SHG members.

- **National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM):** 3622 SHG members have been recommended by State Urban Livelihood Mission (SULM) to SNA for seed capital. Rs. 0.84 crore was released to 77 urban SHG members.

- **Project Implementation Plan (PIP):** PIP from 5 states namely Andhra Pradesh, Punjab, Goa, Uttarakhand and Delhi was recommended in the 21th PEC meeting held on 08th June 2022 for placing before IMEC.

- **Progress on Individual Applications:** 2830 individual applications were submitted and 687 loans were sanctioned during the month. Central share of Rs.1.49 crore was released to 379 beneficiaries.

- **Subsidy Release:** Central share of Capital linked grant was released for 379 individual beneficiaries amounting to Rs. 10.48 crore.

a2. Promotional Activities:

- i. 13 Online Webinars / Offline Workshops/ Exhibitions/ Stakeholder Meetings conducted under PMFME Scheme and Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav initiative with media coverage, PMFME Scheme 2 Year Completion Campaign – Video bytes of Hon'ble Minister, FPI and Hon'ble MoS, FPI was released, Press Releases

sent to Press Information Bureau, social media creatives published, PMFME Scheme related social media posts and updates shared regularly.

Meetings:

- 21st Meeting of Project Executive Committee held on 08.06.2022 under chairpersonship of Joint Secretary, FPI.
- Meetings conducted to review the progress of implementation of PMFME Scheme under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, FPI for the state of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka on 28.06.2022, 28.06.2022 & 29.06.2022 respectively.

B. Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Food Processing Industry:

- As per the decisions in the meeting of the Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS) on 09.06.2022, the guidelines for PLI Scheme for Millet Based Products issued on 23.06.2022.
- Submission of Proposals/ Eols for Millet Based Products and Organic Products have also been invited. Notice of Eol was published on Ministry's website and in newspaper on 28.06.2022.

C. Progress Under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojna (PMKSY):

- **Modification of Guidelines:** The scheme guidelines of Agro Processing Cluster Scheme (APC), Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC), Cold Chain, Operation Green and Food Testing Lab (FTL) were modified & notified on 08.06.2022.
- Expression of Interest (EOI) for inviting proposals on component schemes of PMKSY was invited on 27.06.2022 with last date of application is 10.08.2022. Notice of Eol published on website on 21.06.2022.

C-1. Cold Chain:

- Approval letters were issued to 2 eligible cold chain projects.

C-2. Operation Greens

- 37th MOG meeting was held on 10.06.2022 under Chairpersonship of Joint Secretary, FPI to consider the claim applications received for transportation/ storage subsidy under extended Operation Greens (TOP to TOTAL) scheme.

C-3. NIFTEM:

(A). NIFTEM, Thanjavur:

- Hon'ble Union Minister, FPI, Shri Pashupati Kumar Paras visited the NIFTEM Thanjavur's Liaison Office, Guwahati on 15th June 2022 and interacted with officials about the facilities.
- NIFTEM, Thanjavur and CUTN Thiruvapur jointly observed country-wide celebrations of International Yoga Day on 21st June 2022 at "The Great Living Chola Temple, Thanjavur" celebration of which was graced by Smt. Annapurna Devi, Hon'ble MoS for Education.
