Ministry of Food Processing Industries - Report for November, 2022

1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1.1 Major achievements during the month:

A. Aatmanirbhar Bharat:

a. Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME): -

Various actions taken/developments in the month of November, 2022 in the implementation of the Scheme are as under:

a1. Implementation Status: -

- **Progress on Individual Applications:** 8689 individual applications were submitted and 2520 loans sanctioned. Subsidy release: Centre share of Rs. 20.20 crore released to 1144 beneficiaries.
- **Capacity Building:** 1267 Beneficiaries trained in 25 States/ UTs 58 DLTs and 183 DRPs trained under EDP and ODOP.
- **Seed Capital:**

National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM): 1425 SHG members have been recommended by State Urban Livelihood Mission (SULM) to SNA for amount of Rs. 4.57 Cr. for seed capital. Rs. 1.61 Cr released against 371 urban SHG members.

National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM): 5089 SHG members recommended for an amount of Rs 18.26 Cr. Rs. 25.31Cr released against 5726 SHG members.

- Out of 352 cold chain projects sanctioned by the Ministry, 269 have been reported completion and started commercial operation.

C-3. Food Testing Lab:

- Project Approval Committee in its meeting held on 29.11.2022 considered the FTL proposals/ applications received against Expression of Interest (EOI) dated 21.06.2022 under the Scheme of Setting-up/ Up-gradation of Food Testing

Laboratories and approved 13 proposals out of 74 proposals which grant-in-aid of about 46 crores.

- A meeting of Technical Committee (TC) held on 24.11.2022 through Video Conferencing (VC) for considering the proposals received under the CEFPPC Scheme.
