As per the instructions contained in Cabinet Secretary's ID. No. 601/2/1/2014 (Vol.III)-TS dated 28.04.2016, I am sending herewith a report of the initiatives taken by the Ministry during the month of October, 2022 for your kind perusal.

2. MoFPI has completed the process of selection of beneficiary companies under the PLI Scheme for Milled based Products and approvals have been issued after Approval Committee's meeting on 06.10.2022. A total of 33 applicants have been granted approval including 3 in the Organic category. Meanwhile, the process for disbursement of incentive claims under PLI Scheme for Food Processing Industries have been initiated with the receipt of first set of claims.

3. The Project Approval Committee (PAC) under the PMKSY, has considered and approved 21 projects for Agro Processing Cluster and 110 projects under the Scheme for Creation / Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC). The projects have a gestation period of 18 months and will add to food processing capacity.

4. The Ministry has organized Swachhta Special Campaign-2.0 from 02.10.2022 to 31.10.2022. The Ministry also celebrated "Rashtriya Ekta Diwas" on the occasion of 147th Birth Anniversary of Late Shri Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on 31.10.2022 and also all the officials/officers took oath on the occasion of "Rashtriya Ekta Diwas".

Ministry of Food Processing Industries - Report for October, 2022

1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1.1 Major achievements during the month:

A. Aatmanirbhar Bharat:

a. Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME): -

Various actions taken/developments in the month of October, 2022 in the implementation of the Scheme are as under:

a1. Implementation Status: -

- **Capacity Building:** 842 Beneficiaries trained in 22 States/ UTs.
- **Seed Capital:**
National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM): 12,820 SHG members have been recommended by State Urban Livelihood Mission (SULM) to SNA for amount of Rs. 48.58 Cr. for seed capital. Rs. 4.49 Cr released against 1250 urban SHG members.
- **Progress on Individual Applications:** 6447 individual applications were submitted and 1664 loans sanctioned. Subsidy release: Centre share of Rs. 7.94 crore released to 360 beneficiaries:

B. Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Food Processing Industry:

- A review meeting was held with Project Management Agency (PMA) on 17.10.2022 to assess the status of disbursement of incentive claim under PLI Scheme.
- 5th meeting of Approval Committee was held on 06.10.2022 and approvals were accorded to 33 applicants under various categories of PLI Scheme.
- Consultations with Stakeholders were held on 31.10.2022 to deliberate upon proposed new PLIS for Nutraceutical and Wine & Spirits sectors respectively.

C. Progress under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojna (PMKSY):

C-1. NIFTEM:

(A). NIFTEM-Thanjavur:

- NIFTEM, Thanjavur conducted First Board of Governors Meeting on 28.10.2022 under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.S. Sodhi, Managing Director, GCMMF (Amul).

- NIFTEM, Thanjavur organized a Mini Marathon (awareness event for the International Year of Millets 2023) under the name "Run for Millet" on the occasion of World Food Day on 16th October 2022.
- Smt. Anita Praveen, Secretary, Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Government of India inaugurated the One Day Workshop on Millet Foods: Design, Development and Sensory Evaluation organized on 11th October 2022 at NIFTEM-Thanjavur in the presence of Vice Chancellor, TNJFU and President, AFSTI.
- NIFTEM, Thanjavur received approvals for two new grant-in-aid projects under the Scheme for Young Scientists and Technologists of DST, Government of India.
- Smt. Anita Praveen, Secretary, Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Government of India visited MPR Foods, Trichy & Bliss Tree, Trichy.

(B). NIFTEM-Sonepat:

- NIFTEM, Sonepat has set up "Food Monitoring Committee" in NIFTEM Campus.
- NIFTEM, Sonepat organized "Swachhta Pakhwada Exhibition" and "Quiz competition on Swachhta Pakhwada" on 28.10.2022.
- NIFTEM, Sonepat organized Hindi Pakhwada was organized from 14 – 28 Sep, 2022.

C-2. Cold Chain:

- Meeting of the Project Approval Committee (IMAC) under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 27.10.2022.
- Meeting of Technical Committee (TC) under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, FPI held in October, 2022.
- As on date, 352 Cold Chain projects have been sanctioned by the Ministry, out of which 268 have been reported completion and started commercial operation.

C-3. Food Testing Lab:

- Grant in Aid of Rs. 0.8492 crore has been released during the month of October 2022.

- A Technical Committee Meeting held in the month of October 2022 to evaluate the proposals/ applications received against Expression of Interest (EOI) dated 21.06.2022 under the Scheme of Setting-up/ Up-gradation of Food Testing Laboratories.

C-4. Operation Green:

- Project Approval Committee (PAC) Meeting held on 20.10.2022 to consider the proposals received against EOI dated 21.06.2022. PAC approved 44 proposals for financial assistance amounting to ₹436.64 crore with private investment leverage of ₹1587.81 crore.

C-5. Agro Processing Cluster:

- A meeting of Project Approval Committee (PAC) was held under the chairmanship by Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 14.10.2022 for considering proposals received against Expression of Interest (EOI) dated 21.06.2022 under Scheme for Creation of Agro Processing Clusters (APC). Twenty one (21) projects have been found eligible by the PAC with total project cost of Rs. 702.56 Cr. Including grants-in-aid outgo of Rs. 196.01 crore, which will leverage Rs. 506.55 crore of private investment.

C-6. Creation / Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC):

- A meeting of Project Approval Committee (PAC) was held under the chairmanship by Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 26.10.2022 for considering proposals received against Expression of Interest (EOI) dated 21.06.2022 under Scheme for Creation / Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC). One Hundred Ten (110) projects have been approved by the PAC subject to availability of funds and vacant slots under the category with total project cost of Rs. 1648.06 Cr. Including grants-in-aid outgo of Rs. 433.15 crore, which will leverage Rs. 1214.91 crore of private investment. However, with the present funds available under the Scheme, only for 87 out of 110 projects approved by PAC, can be sanctioned and remaining 23 projects cannot be sanctioned for grants-in-aid presently, as sufficient funds are not available.

- MoFPI's participation in **SIAL Paris** – a delegation led by Joint Secretary FPI participated in SIAL Paris 2022 to showcase myriad opportunities in Indian food processing sector as well as promote the mega food event proposed to be organised by the Ministry in October 2023.
