## **Ministry of Food Processing Industries- Report for September, 2019**

### **1.0 Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

#### **1.1 Important policy decision taken during the month: Nil**

#### **1.2 Major achievements during the month**

Under the Umbrella Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY), the following progress is achieved against each of the component schemes:

##### **1.2.1 Creation/Expansion of Food Processing and Preservation Capacities (Unit Scheme):**

Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI was held on 25.09.2019 for considering the proposals received for CEFPPC under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana and approved 3 food processing units in various states of the country. These projects will leverage Rs. 30.13 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 10.65 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 2004.56 crore.

##### **1.2.2 Scheme for Agro-Processing Clusters (APC):**

Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI was held on 25.09.2019 for considering the proposals received for APC under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana and approved 3 agro processing cluster in various states of the country. These projects will leverage Rs. 50.10 crore of investment and involve subsidy outgo of Rs. 28.738 crore. Cumulative investment leveraged under the Scheme till date is Rs. 964.11 crore.

##### **1.2.3 Operation Greens:**

5<sup>th</sup> Inter-Ministerial Approval Committee (IMAC) chaired by Hon'ble Minister, FPI held on 23.09.2019 for considering the recommendations of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Mission Operation Greens Meetings and approved two proposals in the State of Maharashtra and West Bengal for investments in Onion & Potato crops respectively.

#### **1.2.4 Scheme for Creation of Backward & Forward Linkages:**

Sanction letter for 02 nos of projects has been issued with total Grant in Aid of Rs. 9.33 Crore.

#### **1.2.5 Mega Food Park:**

- a. Hon'ble Minister, FPI inaugurated Mega Food Park project in Nizamabad, Telangana being implemented by M/s Smart Agro Food Park Pvt. Ltd on 06.09.2019.
- b. Letter of award for evaluation of the impact of Mega Food Park was issued on 27.09.2019.

#### **1.2.6 Cold Chain Scheme:**

During this month, under the scheme of Integrated Cold Chain & Value Addition Infrastructure of PMKSY Seven (7) cold chain projects have reported completion and start of commercial operations. Total no. of projects completed under the scheme is 177.

#### **1.2.7 IIFPT:**

- a. IIFPT organized Open day on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 where more than 20000 people visited. The need and potential of food processing was explained to visitors through a range of events, stalls for entrepreneurs incubated through IIFPT, demonstrations, cultural shows and a national level science exhibition on food processing.
- b. IIFPT entered into MoU with NRCB-ICAR on 17.09.2019 to take up joint research on value addition of banana, it's waste and by-products.

#### **1.2.8 NIFTEM:**

- a. A two days' workshop on 'Google Power Searching, Information Management and Neuro Linguistic Programming' was organized from 27-28<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 with a total 80 participants from NIFTEM and other institutes.
- b. A two days' workshop on 'Innovative Food Packaging and testing' was organized from 12-13<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 in a collaboration with CIPET, Murthal with a total 130 participants from NIFTEM and other institutes.

a. Japanese Ambassador to India met Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 12.09.2019 to discuss issues of mutual interest.

b. A delegation from France headed by Mr. Geoffroy Roux de' Bezieux, President of MEDEF met Hon'ble Minister, FPI on 24.09.2019.
